



## Terms & Conditions

### Theme

1. Art Against AIDS 2011 continues with the theme of “Living with...”. Participants are encouraged to explore issues related to people living with HIV/AIDS in Singapore.

### Project Framework

2. This is a SHORT FILM competition organised by Action for AIDS Singapore (AfA).
3. All entries should be 3 to 5 minutes duration and must be submitted in a readable DVD format.
4. Teams are to ensure that they own or have the necessary licenses, rights, consents, and permissions to the contents of the film.
5. The submissions may be in any genre, including documentaries and fictional films.
6. This competition is open to all students from tertiary institutions in Singapore. This includes universities, polytechnics, ITE and other diploma or degree-granting private institutions in Singapore.
7. Each team must comprise of students from the same institution.
8. Action for AIDS reserves the right to use, reproduce, and publicly display all entered works for the purpose of this competition and for future HIV/AIDS awareness campaigns/events.

### Project Timeline

9. All teams must be registered with AfA by **July 17<sup>th</sup> 2011** by submitting the attached form to [art.against.aids@afa.org.sg](mailto:art.against.aids@afa.org.sg)
10. Participants must attend an Introduction Session on **July 23<sup>rd</sup> 2011** for a briefing on the project and to interact with volunteers, social workers and people living with HIV/AIDS to better understand the issues relating to HIV/AIDS.
11. Teams are to submit scripts to AfA for review and feedback by **11 August**.

12. Final films must be submitted to AfA by **10 October 2011** in-person or via mail at the following address:

### **Notification of Winners**

14. Works will be judged on their originality, creative impact, composition and their net effect of promoting HIV/AIDS awareness and understanding by a panel comprising AfA representatives, People living with HIV/AIDS and Royston Tan, a leading Singaporean filmmaker.

15. Winners will be notified by post and via email by 20 November and an awards ceremony and screening will be held in December 2011 in conjunction with World AIDS Day.
